

Parsons Plantation Pool COVID-19 Plan 2021 Season

At this time, the COVID-19 risk level is volatile and conditions over the summer are uncertain. The PPPOA Pool Committee has adopted the following policy this season to manage COVID-19 risk in a flexible and data-driven manner.

Throughout the summer, the Pool Committee will monitor the community transmission level for Gwinnett County as reported by the CDC COVID Data Tracker.

Approximately once a week, the Committee will post the current pool restrictions prominently in the pool area.

Transmission Level	Parties Allowed?	Guests Allowed
High	No	None
Substantial	No	None
Moderate	No	Maximum of 5
Low	Yes	Maximum of 5

Social Distancing

Social distancing between households is strongly encouraged at all times for adults at the pool. We will not be enforcing social distancing for children, but please be considerate and understanding that some families may want a buffer around their children. Let's all make our own informed decisions, and be respectful of others' decisions.

Notes:

- At any time, Georgia or Gwinnett County might impose stricter restrictions.
- You are responsible for checking the posted restrictions every time you use the pool. Violations may result in loss of pool privileges for the seasons **without refund**.
- If you plan a pool party and the COVID-19 community transmission level makes the event unsafe to hold, then you can reschedule your event or receive a full refund at your option.
